### **Adoption of the Annual Master Schedule of Fees and Charges for City Services 2018-2019**

#### **BACKGROUND**


- A. User fees in California are required to conform to the California Constitution (including Proposition 26) and statutory requirements including Government Code Sections 66014 through 66018.5. User fees imposed to provide specific services, to cover reasonable regulatory costs to issue licenses and permits, for entrance to or use of city property, and fines for violating the City Code are generally excluded from the definition of “tax” under Proposition 26. Section 1 (e) of article XIIC of the California Constitution describes these exceptions.
- B. Staff’s last CPI update was adopted by the City Council on April 3rd, 2018. It is fiscally prudent at this time to adjust fees by the CPI change that has occurred since the previously adopted period.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of South Lake Tahoe:

1. The City of South Lake Tahoe has conducted an analysis of the costs of its services.
2. The City wishes to recover the costs of providing special services, such that general revenues are not diverted from general services to subsidize services.
3. Pursuant to Government Code Section 66016 and 66018, certain specific fees to be charged for services must be adopted by the City Council by Resolution after providing and holding a public hearing.
4. Notice of public hearing has been provided by publication per Government Code Section 6062a, oral and written presentations were made and received, and the required public hearing was held.
5. It is the intention of the City Council to charge the new fee amounts according to the implementation dates as set forth in the applicable codes and all fees and charges as presented in the attached Master Fee Schedule are hereby to be computed and applied by the various City departments.
