Tuesday, July 4, 2017, parade begins at 10am
The City of South Lake Tahoe is hosting a 4th of July parade on Tuesday, July 4, 2017 from the "Y" where Highways 89 and 50 intersect to Bijou Community Park off of Al Tahoe Blvd, beginning at 10am. The annual parade honors our local veterans and the American Legion Post 795 who will serve as the parade marshals. There will be an "After Party" at Bijou Community Park located at 1201 Al Tahoe Blvd. The party will begin immediately following the conclusion of the parade featuring a BBQ with all proceeds going to the American Legion. Motorists can expect delays from 9:45am to 11am on the two eastbound lanes of Highway 50 from the "Y" to Al Tahoe Blvd. as there will be a "rolling closure" for the parade. The two westbound lanes of Highway 50 from Stateline to the "Y" will remain open. **Motorists are to expect traffic to be slow and we encourage motorists to utilize Pioneer Trail during and immediately following the parade.**
