South Lake Tahoe Police Seek Information on Unknown Assailant

South Lake Tahoe CA (July 5, 2017)- On Monday, June 26, 2017, South Lake Tahoe Police Department patrol officers responded to a 9-1-1 call in the area of Park Av, between Cedar Av and Lake Tahoe BI, near Hotel Becket. Officers responded and found the victim, identified as 23-year-old Adam Albaugh of Pennsylvania, unresponsive and suffering from a significant head injury.

Officers contacted several witnesses who provided statements about the incident. The witnesses told officers that an unknown, unidentified Hispanic male adult had chased Albaugh down the street, and tackled Albaugh. According to witnesses, this action of tackling caused Albaugh to fall to the ground and strike his head.

The unknown Hispanic male adult was described as approximately 5'10" tall, weighing approximately 200 lbs, with short black hair. The male was wearing dark-colored clothing, according to multiple witnesses.

The unknown Hispanic male was accompanied by a dark-complexioned white female, approximately 5'06" tall and approximately 140 lbs, wearing like clothing. Her identity is also unknown.

Investigators from SLTPD obtained video surveillance footage that may have captured the two unknown subjects. The South Lake Tahoe Police Department is requesting the public's assistance with identifying the people in these photos. The people pictured are not considered suspects at this time.
