City Manager Nancy Kerry Resigns

South Lake Tahoe, CA (March 6, 2018) – Today, South Lake Tahoe City Council accepted the resignation of City Manager Nancy Kerry, effective March 6, 2018. Ms. Kerry has served as City Manager for five and a half years and has been an employee of the City for nearly ten years.

The City's leadership team has much to be proud of over the past years. Working together, the Council, Ms. Kerry and the City's executive team developed an effective strategic business plan, guided economic development efforts that brought thriving new businesses to town, eliminated more than \$60 million in debts and unfunded liabilities and strengthened the City's financial status and community partnerships.

"The Council and I appreciate Ms. Kerry's service to the City. She has been able to move the City forward in significant ways," said Mayor Wendy David. "We wish her all the best in her next chapter."
