Hotels/motels which are used for long-term rentals were constructed for short-term use and lack health and safety features.

The City of South Lake Tahoe is proposing to improve the living conditions at hotels and motels through a draft ordinance.

The City contains about 120 hotels/motels with more than 5,000 rooms. About 25% of these rooms are used for long-term rentals on either a continuous or seasonal basis.

These units present health and safety issues for the occupants, the neighborhood and the community. The proposed ordinance would require upgrades and routine city inspections to ensure basic health and safety standards.
