Construction of the Project is scheduled to commence in early July, 2015. Construction of the Project will occur throughout the 2015 and 2016 summer construction seasons. The public is encouraged to learn more about this important project to reduce erosion and sediment discharges in to the Upper Truckee River and Lake Tahoe.

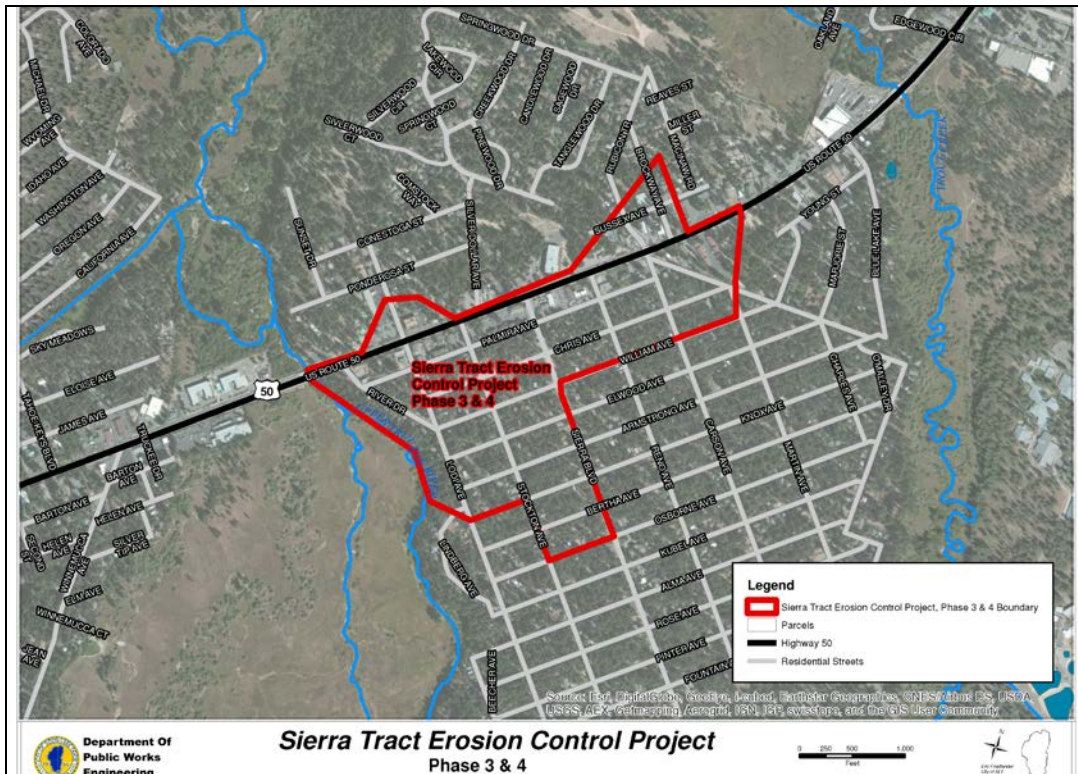
