RE: AARP Senior Community Service Employment Program has open positions in El Dorado County and South Lake Tahoe

The local office of AARP is currently seeking applicants for the work training program. All applicants must meet the low income qualifications and apply through AARP. On behalf of the SLT Senior Center I have requested a receptionist position to fill the afternoon vacancy. Once applicants have been qualified through AARP I will conduct interviews to determine which candidate is best suited for the receptionist position.

Several other positions within South Lake Tahoe and El Dorado County are also available. Candidates who apply for the SLT Senior Center who are not selected for the reception position have an opportunity to be placed with another agency.

All applications are distributed and reviewed by AARP. Any questions or assistance needed to complete the application will be provided by the local AARP representative.

Individuals are placed in a wide variety of activities at non-profit and public facilities like day cares, senior centers, schools and hospitals. This on-the-job training experience can then be used as a bridge to find employment opportunities outside of the program.

In addition to job and community service placement, AARP Foundation SCSEP provides participants with training and support services that are important for finding future employment, like Individual Employment Plan (IEP) development, specialized training, wages and fringe benefits, annual physicals, assistance in securing future employment and access to local American Job Centers—formerly known as One-Stop Career Centers.
